So many items have been scoped out that the Environmental Assessment will not provide the likely significant effects of the proposed development, nor will it determine the cumulative effects. Whilst PfE is mentioned, there is no reference to any of the policies in the Plan, nor how they will be taken into consideration in the Environmental Assessment. In addition, the New Carrington Masterplan team has not yet published the natural infrastructure information/requirements for the whole site - how will these be taken into consideration?
