

We are asking supporters to help us by securing sponsorship for our Nature Walk on 18th April 2026.

Why is this important? Well Carrington Moss is currently home to red listed birds and endangered wildlife species. Trafford's own documentation confirms that, if construction is approved on this ecology-rich habitat, there will be Countyscale decline in species. That is an impact that goes well beyond the New Carrington boundaries.

This means the proposals for New Carrington are not sustainable!

Why should Carrington Moss be preserved?

The value of its Natural Capital ecosystem benefits should be assessed!



A unique land area extremely well-used by human communities and populations of red listed birds and endangered wildlife. It currently comprises a 335 hectare peat moss (considered by Natural England to be irreplaceable and restorable), productive Grade 2 agricultural land, woodland and wetland. Criss-crossed by footpaths and bridleways, it provides a number of health and wellbeing benefits, including the hacking routes for the over 1,000 horses stabled in the area.
